Bought flowers/foilage may be used along with drapes, backdrops and props provided the complete display is within the stated measurement

- S58 An arrangement of your choice with suitable title\*\* – (no bigger than 20" x 20" no height restriction)
- S59 An arrangement using foliage only (no bigger than 14" x 14" – no height restriction)
- S60 A Christmas/winter arrangement\*\* – (no bigger than 18" x 18" no height restriction)
- S61 An arrangement using 3 flowers plus foliage (no bigger than 12" x 12" no height restriction)

\*\* Arrangements can be done in either fresh, silk or dried flowers

## PHOTOGRAPHY

There are separate categories for both digital and non-digital photographs. Please ensure they are entered in correct category if they are in the incorrect one they will not be judged. The judge has given advice for each category which we have included below.

*Judges Note* - For competitors to display their photographs to give the best impression it is advisable that they are mounted on a card of a colour to draw the eye into the image

- S79 **Environment** - This should project where we live it gives a great deal of scope & must be a scape
- S80 **Architecture** - This can be dereliction, street art, environmental issues, transport and so forth
- S81 **Humanity** - People engaging in activities, emotions – this is an open your eyes section. It gives so much scope e.g. dog walking, baking, skipping & the list goes on
- S82 **Nature** – If wildlife comes into this section it does not matter if it is captive or in the wild. It will be judged on its quality. Any part of nature – insects, flowers and so on
- S83 **Anything goes** – this is a great section with no rules applied any theme accepted
